### Phase 1: The application

### Phase 2: Telephone Interview

A member of the team will contact you to have an informal chat about your CV and experience.

### Phase 3: Presentation

Successful candidates will be invited to FunTech Maidenhead to present a series of tasks. You will be required to fill out a DBS check form and will need two of the following identification documents:

- PASSPORT
- DRIVING LICENCE
- NATIONAL INSURANCE CARD

One of the above can be replaced by a utility bill or bank statement

The objective is to gauge your preparation ability, your method of delivering both simple and complex concepts and how you handle potential problems.

### Phase 3 Continued: The Tasks (all tasks are compulsory)

Task

1

Programming

**Target Audience:** Mixed Ability 11+ year olds

**Method of Delivery:** Presentation with exercises

**Objective:** Java (beginner | intermediate | advanced)

Specific content to cover, all of which must have an exercise for the audience.

- What is an IDE, hello world exercise, reading text and displaying variables.
- Explain IF statements & For loops including nesting.
- Explain the difference between procedural & object oriented programming.
- Explain the difference between a class & an object.
- Demonstrate how you can create a basic class and then demonstrate it.
- Explain Inheritance.

2

Minecraft

**Target Audience:** All ages, Mixed Ability

**Method of Delivery:** Presentation

**Objective:** Redstone elevator

Redstone elevator must be created prior to the presentation

- What is Redstone.
- What Redstone components exist.
- How does a Redstone elevator work.
- Explanation of how to build a Redstone elevator.

Task

3

FPS Creator

**Target Audience:** All ages, Mixed Ability

**Method of Delivery:** Presentation

**Objective:** You will be given a partially completed game and then asked to add and explain additional features. You will be given a brief on the day of what you will need to achieve.



#### Phase 4: Offer & Contract

Successful candidates will be offered a position. On acceptance, contracts will be posted out to complete, sign and return. Please be sure to read all the terms and conditions that you are agreeing to.

#### Phase 5: Contract signed & DBS Check

Once contracts have been signed and received, DBS checks will be carried out on each candidate. If an unsuccessful DBS report is given the contract will be null and void.

#### Phase 6: Full Training (including First Aid)

Depending on the role, you will be given a clear brief on your training objectives. You will be required to do some preliminary work prior to attending our training, at a location to be advised. Travel expenses will be paid. You will be required to pass a First Aid Training day.
